



Scholarships

The United Methodist Higher Education Foundation provides more than \$2 million in scholarships every year to United Methodist students attending UM-related institutions of higher education. The General Named Endowed Scholarship Program is a traditional program that includes awards of various amounts from named funds established by various donors.
