

Our VBS 2022 participants enjoyed a wonderful three days on "Adventure Island," during which our sanctuary and church grounds transformed into a tropical paradise!

During each night's opening assembly, Sandy Simpson led the kids in lively worship songs and choreography; and both Rev Bruce and our youth acting troupe brought three featured stories to life--the creation story, the paralytic through the roof, and the prodigal son. Our center leaders engaged kids with all sorts of creative, educational, and spiritual play: crafts, games, science experiments, Biblical activities, and mission outreach; not to mention, all the delicious snacks we ate!

Seventeen families participated, with a total of twenty-seven kids from age three to fifth grade. We had eight youth helpers, and over thirty adult volunteers. Thanks to all who helped and participated! It was a blessing to learn, sing, laugh, and play together. Although this year's VBS has come to an end, we hope you all continue to *shine* with LOVE, FAITH, and JOY.



Calling all singers, ringers and anyone else who would enjoy taking part in the music ministry at Hudson UMC! All are welcome, even if you would just like to sit in on our rehearsals. Here is what we have going on this fall:

<u>Chancel Choir</u> -High school age through adult singers who offer an anthem and occasional choral response for the majority of worship services. (We do take some Sundays off). Rehearsals are **Thursday evenings from 7:30-9:00** and will begin on Thursday, September 8th. It is not necessary to read music to praise God and sing.

Wesley Ringers - A handbell choir of age's high school through adult. Each ringer is typically responsible for playing two bells as they occur in the music. It isn't necessary to read music. We play approximately one Sunday per month, and rehearse from 6:15-7:15 on Thursday evenings. Our first rehearsal will be Thursday, September 8th.

<u>Crusader Choir</u> – Our children's choir, Grades 1-6. We rehearse as part of a worship experience, which is incorporated into Sunday school time on Sunday mornings. We sing approximately once per month for worship services. We will begin to meet on Sunday, **September 18**th.

<u>Flute Choir - A</u> group of flutists who play for worship three or four times per year. Rehearsals are scheduled according to availability.

<u>Instrumentalists</u> - Please let me know if you play an instrument and would be willing to participate as a soloist or play an instrumental part for one of our choir anthems. It greatly enhances and adds vibrancy to worship. We are also considering starting a men's and women's ensemble, along with expanding our children and youth music opportunities once we get the above groups firmly established.

Please know that I am here for anyone who would like help learning the music we are working on or to develop additional music skills. We can schedule times that are convenient for you.



<u>MUSIC MINISTRY PICNIC</u> – Kick off our season and share fellowship with members of our music ministry and their families: Singers, ringers, anyone who has interest in our music ministry in the future, along with families and/or significant others.
