
#### **WALKING Hikes**

## **A Message from our Trustees**

#### In Need of Repair

The Care & Repair Fund has been hit with a string of necessary expenses over the last 2 years. The purpose of this fund is to cover major unexpected replacement and repair costs to protect General Fund from major cuts to church day to day operations. The Trustees seek to have this reserve maintain a balance of over \$20,000. Our building is 57 years old and the Trustees are always prioritizing among needed replacements and critical repairs. The Care & Repair Fund balance is now under \$5,000. So far this year we have needed to tackle over \$24,000 of major expenses: generator replacement; the parsonage's furnace, sump pump, and dishwasher replacements; and \$9600 of church exterior painting (deferred from 2024). Last year flood remediation, electrical replacements and upgrades were undertaken to catch up from water and lightning damage totaling about \$25,000.

Please consider generously adding a regular pledge amount designated to the Care & Repair Fund OR consider a onetime gift to offset these large expenses and prepare our church for the next critical replacement.
