- Jesus, the Twelve, and the women celebrate Hanukkah at an inn across the Jordan from Jerusalem
- Matthew suspects Judas is taking money from the treasury
- Frustrated that his money-raising schemes are rejected, Judas talks to Jesus, who tells him to pay close attention to the upcoming sermon in Jerusalem
- Confronted by religious leaders in Jerusalem, Jesus makes his identity plain; they respond by attempting to stone him
- When James is struck in the forehead, Jesus and the disciples flee back to the inn, arriving at night
- After Zebedee arrives and tells of a plot to kill Jesus, Jesus announces that Lazarus has died
