## **Agenda**

Begin planning for Rally Day on Sunday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, where we will introduce HUMC's Discipleship Pathway to the congregation and gather input from church members on how we can further support their spiritual growth.

## **Meeting notes:**

Steve introduced a book he is reading entitled <u>Calling on Fire: Reclaiming the Method of Methodism by Ashley</u>
<u>Boggan and Chris Heckert</u>

- A short description: Many Methodists today feel adrift and seek to renew their churches. Calling on Fire
  draws on Methodist history as a guide for faithful, effective ministry, offering practical tools rooted in
  real-world experience. It helps churches facing decline rediscover their mission through field preaching,
  micro-communities, social engagement, and bold leadership.
- Steve highlighted a section of the book that talked about Grace Groups, small groups of 8-12 that meet regularly for spiritual support. Time is set aside at these gatherings for Soul Tending, God Sightings and Growing in Grace.
- Groups similar to these might play an important role in a discipleship-focused church community like Hudson UMC.
- We'll stay tuned for more learnings from this book as we progress through our discipleship pathway work.

### Set-Up:

- 6 round tables: randomly seated; if larger crowd, pull out more chairs
- Make use of PowerPoint presentation slides and large Monitor (currently on stand outside sanctuary)
- Sound system and 2 microphones
- List of discussion questions provided at each table

#### Four Parts (one-hour meeting):

- 1. Define the discipleship pathway
- 2. Introduce the six keys to discipleship
- 3. Participants' self-assessment
- 4. Gather members' input on how the church may support them in their spiritual growth journeys
